



Eco-Schools Timetable

This infographic suggests a delivery timeline for your Eco-Schools' work, but it is only a suggestion. Work can be completed across a shorter timeline if that suits your setting.

- 1 Time to form an Eco-Committee**
An Eco-Committee is a group of young people who take responsibility for delivering the Eco-Schools programme, with the support of an adult Eco-Coordinator.
- 2 Complete the Environmental Review**
Available to download when you open an Eco-Schools application for the current academic year, the Review is a set of questions designed to help an Eco-Committee pinpoint areas within their school or community where environmental practices can be strengthened.
- 3 Create and work on an Action Plan**
The Eco-Committee plan environmental projects and actions to work on throughout the year focusing on three Eco-Schools topics.
- 4 Curriculum Links**
This step asks you to provide three pieces of evidence demonstrating that your setting delivers environmental learning. This evidence can link to any of the ten Eco-Schools topics.
- 5 Informing and Involving**
Throughout the academic year, Eco-Committees are asked to inform others about their progress and plan opportunities to involve them in Action Plan projects.
- 6 Monitoring and Evaluation**
Eco-Committees are asked to monitor the progress of their projects and evaluate their outcomes. It is important to think about this step early, to gather any data that may be needed. This might be as simple as before and after pictures.
- 7 Create an Eco-Code**
This can take any format and is a pledge to continue protecting our planet.
- 8 Green Flag Application Window Opens**
The Eco-Schools Green Flag application window is open May 1st to July 31st every year. In the meantime, you can update your application at any point and it auto-saves as you go!
