Great British Summer Savings Scheme

The Great British Summer Savings scheme is running from 25th June to 1st September 2026, helping families feel a bit less squeezed this summer. The new scheme includes reduced VAT on days out, including tickets at attractions like soft play, adventure centres and theme parks, children’s tickets for theatre and cinemas, and children’s meals in restaurants. Children aged 5-15 in England will also be able to travel free on local bus services throughout August.
