Collective Worship Reflections

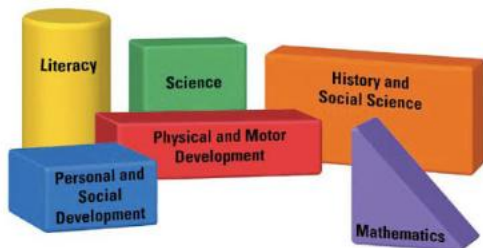
