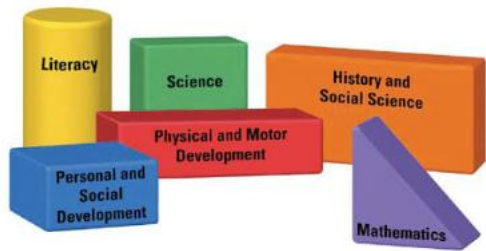
Year 6- SATs
