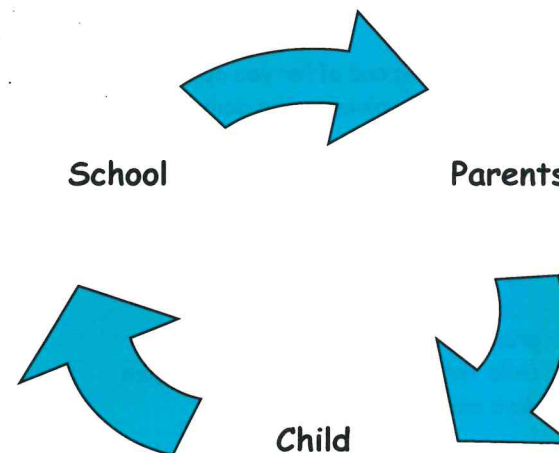

School: We will:

- treat your child fairly, listen to and care for her/him and ensure her/his happiness and safety;
- ensure that your child is well taught and that she/he achieves her/his best in all aspects of school life including healthy lifestyles;
- help your child to develop a sense of responsibility, to be considerate of others and to take pride in the school environment and all areas of school life;
- be welcoming and offer you opportunities to become involved in the daily life of the school;
- provide a full range of subjects and after school activities to meet children's needs and interests;
- provide regular feedback about your child through parent's meetings, open days and progress reports;
- keep you well informed about punctuality, attendance and general school matters;
- operate a clearly stated behaviour policy
- respond to your concerns as promptly as possible and make every effort to ensure we are GDPR compliant.
- celebrate your child's achievements from all areas of school life and share their successes with the school community.

Children: I will:

- come to school every day unless I am unwell, arriving on time and properly equipped;
- behave well in class and during all play times, following my classroom rules and our whole school code of conduct (as displayed on the school playground wall);
- be polite and use good manners at all times;
- respect other people and my property, and take good care of my own possessions;
- respect and keep the school buildings and grounds clean and tidy;
- try hard and show pride in all my work, including homework;
- go to bed at sensible times during the school week;
- tell a member of staff if anything is worrying me.
- share good news with staff and other children.
- understand that I am responsible for my actions and that they will have rewards/sanctions in line with our school behaviour policy.

Parents/Guardians: I/We will:

- support my child's learning at home by hearing them read each day and ensure all written/oral homework activities are done on time.
 - support the school's high expectations of pupil behaviour/safety-includes covid-19 safety measures
 - demonstrate a positive attitude towards the school and respect for the adults working there;
 - ensure my/our own behaviour and language whilst in the school grounds demonstrates respect and tolerance for others and sets a good example for children;
 - make sure my child attends school every day unless they are unwell, arriving on time and properly equipped with personal items clearly marked.
 - notify the school office of reasons for any absence before 8:45am on EACH day of absence;
 - let the school know about any problems which might affect my child's learning, behaviour, happiness or attendance & collect them on time at the end of the school day/after school club activity.
 - encourage my child's independence by allowing them to put school bags, coats etc into their classroom each morning;
 - support the school's uniform and PE kit code;
 - support the school's healthy eating policy, including eating a nutritious breakfast each day.
 - respond to any reasonable requests by the school to discuss my child.
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
